Module 1: Introduction to Business Process Management

Students will learn the the general concepts and practical applications of Business Process Management (BPM). This includes various BPM components including process diagrams, simulation, task management, task approval, process deployment, and process integration.

Module 2: Introduction to Oracle BPM

This module exposes students to the capabilities of the Oracle BPM suite, including BPM Studio, BPM Composer, BPM Workspace, BPM Process Analytics, and WebLogic Server. Students will also receive an overview of the integration of Oracle BPM applications with Oracle SOA applications.

Module 3: Developing a BPM Application using the Oracle BPM Suite

This module teaches students to develop and deploy a BPM application using the Oracle BPM suite of tools. This includes lab exercises with step-by-step instructions for creating a workflow using Oracle BPM Studio. Students will also learn how to simulate a BPM workflow using the process simulation capability. In addition, we will discuss how to deploy a BPM application into Oracle BPM suite, and test it using workspace.

Module 4: Business Activity Monitoring (BAM)

This module instructs students on BAM and its practical applications. Students will learn how BAM helps optimize workflows and processes.

Expected Course Outcomes

This course provides the skills needed to build and manage BPM applications using Oracle BPM tools.
