Module 3: Deploying Applications to WebLogic 12c

In this module, learn how to deploy and test a web application to WebLogic 12c. Students will learn how to manage applications in WebLogic server using the Administration Console.

Module 4: WebLogic Datastore, JMS, Logging, SNMP and Security

In this module, students will receive an overview of various components of the WebLogic Server including Datastore, Queues, Topics, SSL, Logging, Diagnostics, SNMP, and Security.

Module 5: Managing WebLogic Server

This module provides students with an overview of the various ways to manage WebLogic servers, including managing with Oracle Enterprise Manager(OEM) and Node Manager.
